Nicolas WOLFF appointed President of ZE Energy

ZE Energy, a pioneer in energy hybridisation combining battery storage and photovoltaic solutions, announces the appointment of Nicolas Wolff as President. He succeeds Matthieu Lassagne and will be responsible for strengthening ZE Energy's position as a leading European player in both stand-alone and hybrid battery storage, while structuring the company's next phase of growth.

This appointment comes at a key moment for ZE Energy, whose international expansion accelerated in 2025, notably with the securing of a 98.5 MW / 832 MWh storage project in Italy under the MACSE tender scheme.

Nicolas Wolff brings extensive experience across the renewable energy value chain. His career in France and internationally has placed him at the heart of major market transformations, including the industrialisation of wind power, the rapid scaling of solar energy and the structuring of electricity markets.

From 2019 to 2025, as Head of Europe at **Boralex**, he led a decisive growth phase, increasing operational capacity from 950 MW to 1,500 MW, accelerating diversification into solar energy and opening the UK market. Prior to this, he held senior management positions at **Vestas**, the global leader in wind energy, across strategic markets including France, Southern Europe and West Africa. In these roles, he contributed to the development of renewable energy markets and to the professionalisation of the sector as it reached industrial scale.

A graduate of the Institut Supérieur du Commerce de Paris and the IMD Executive Program, Nicolas Wolff is also actively involved in shaping the future of the energy sector. He serves as **Vice President of France Renouvelables** and is a **member of the Board of Directors of UFE**, contributing to discussions on the evolution of the electricity system.

« Energy storage solutions have become essential to support the continued deployment of renewable energies and to strengthen grid stability. ZE Energy is a pioneering company with recognized expertise in hybridisation, combining storage and photovoltaic technologies, and is supported by leading investors such as Marguerite, Amundi, Demeter and Sorégies. My priority will be to accelerate this momentum by structuring and scaling a fast-growing company across Europe, with the ambition of establishing ZE Energy as a key player in the next phase of the energy transition, combining large-scale electrification with grid stabilization, » said Nicolas Wolff.
